**The Gospel Becomes Flesh (1-19)**

1. Compare verse 1 of the Inspired Version with verse 1 of the King James Version. How are they different? Can the KJV translation of this verse be applied to our faith? What is the significance of this verse in either translation?
2. John says that Jesus is the light of men. Read Section 85:2,3. What do these scriptures literally tell us about Jesus?
3. What was the purpose of John the Baptist's ministry?
4. What does verse 13 tell us about the birth of Jesus? About His divinity? Compare this verse with the King James Version. How is it different? Is the KJV translation applicable to Restoration theology?
5. What is the significance of verse 14? Is John echoing these same thoughts in his epistle, 1 John 4:2,3? What is the importance of Jesus coming in the flesh?
6. Does the Law of Moses save us? What comes through Jesus Christ? Why can't the Law save us?

**John the Baptist Denies Being the Christ (20-29)**

7. What verse from the Old Testament is John the Baptist quoting in verse 24 in his reply to the Jews?
8. John the Baptist said that he baptized with water. What would the person who came after him baptize with?

**Jesus the Lamb of God**

9. What sign was John the Baptist told he would see that would enable him to know Jesus?

### **Jesus' First Disciples (35-42)**

10. One of John the Baptist's disciples that followed Jesus was Andrew. Who was the other?
11. What name did Jesus give to Andrew's brother? What does it mean?

### **Jesus Calls Phillip and Nathanael (43-51)**

12. What Old Testament scripture was Philip referring to when he said to Nathanael, "We have found him, of whom Moses in the law...did write..."?
13. When Nathaneal met Jesus, what did Jesus do that caused him to believe that He was the "Son of God"?
14. What greater sign did Jesus say that Nathanael would see?
