Jesus Feeds the Five Thousand (1-15)

1. Why did the crowd of people follow Jesus?
2. What question did Jesus ask of Philip? What was Philip's answer?
3. What was Andrew's response to this problem of feeding the people? Was Andrew 'looking at God through the problem' or 'looking at the problem through God'? What is the difference?
4. How many 'men' were in the crowd?
5. How many 'loaves and fishes' did the disciples of Jesus give to the people?
6. How much food was left over? Read Malachi 3:10. When God blesses us, are there leftovers?

Jesus Walks on the Water (16-24)

7. How long is a furlong? How far had the disciples rowed?

Jesus the Bread of Life (25-59)

8. What was the reason Jesus said the people sought after Him?
9. What was Jesus' answer when the people ask him what must they do to do the works of God?
10. What did the people ask of Jesus that they might believe in Him?
11. Read Exodus 16:1-15. The scriptures say that this was "bread from heaven". How often, though, did the people have to eat it? What did Jesus say was the "true bread of heaven"? How hungry will people be who eat it?

12. Who's will was it that Jesus should come to earth and die for us? What will happen to those who believe in Jesus?
13. Read Section 17:22,23. What is the bread a symbol of? What is the wine a symbol of? Compare this scripture with verses 54-56. What are we partaking of in the Lord's supper?

14. What are the words that Jesus speaks to us? (verse 63)
15. What did Peter answer when Jesus asked the rest of the disciples, "Will ye also go away?" Does Jesus offer "a way of life" or "the way of life"? How so? What is your testimony of the "True Bread of Heaven"?
