**Jesus Goes to the Feast of Tabernacles (1 – 13)**

1. What is the feast of Tabernacles? At what time of year is it celebrated? What other name was it called? (Refer to Leviticus 23:39-44)
2. Did Jesus' brothers believe He was the Messiah? How many brothers did Jesus have? What are their names? (See Matthew 13:56)
3. Why did Jesus' brothers want Him to go to Jerusalem for the feast? Why did Jesus say He would not go? Did He go? How did He go?
4. What was the topic of conversation among the people when Jesus arrived at Jerusalem?

**Jesus Teaches at the Feast (14 – 24)**

5. What did Jesus say about His teachings? Who's were they?
6. Why were the Jews angry with Jesus? (Refer to chapter 5) What was the law of circumcision? To whom was it first given? (See Genesis 17) What part of the anatomy did Moses tell the Israelites to circumcise? (See Deuteronomy 10:16)

**Is Jesus the Christ? (25 – 44)**

7. Matthew 7:36, 37 says "...the people were astonished at His doctrine; for He taught them as one having authority from God, and not as having authority from the scribes. How was Jesus able to do this? (See verses 28, 29; also Colossians 2:9)
8. What is the Hebrew word for "Christ"? What does it mean?
9. What did Jesus say on the last day of the feast? How did He say it? What was the reaction of the people to this saying? Does this type of reaction still happen today? (See Luke 12:60 – 62)

### **Unbelief of Jewish Leaders (45-53)**

10. The temple guard had been sent to arrest Jesus, yet returned empty-handed to the chief priests and Pharisees. What was their explanation to them for not having arrested Jesus?
