5. What do you think it means to pray in Jesus’ name? Is it a blank check whereby we can get anything we want? Are there conditions in praying in His name, i.e., praying within His will and purpose, by His authority, etc?

Jesus Promises the Holy Spirit (15 – 31)

6. Jesus promises to send us the “Comforter” (Holy Ghost). What is our part in order to receive this promise?
7. What are some of the other names for the “Comforter”? (See verse 17, Romans 8:9, 2 Nephi 3:40, Mosiah 1:20, Alma 3:78 and Alma 13:21)
8. Why cannot the world receive the “Spirit of truth”?
9. How do we show our love for Jesus?
10. What will the “Comforter” do for us?
11. Read Luke 2:8-14. Jesus came to bring peace. How is His peace different from the peace that the world can give or cannot give? Can the world take His peace away from you?
