Jesus Arrested (1 – 11)

1. What was the name of the garden that Jesus and His disciples went to? What does the name mean?
2. What happened to the men who came to arrest Jesus the first time He identified Himself?
3. What did Peter do when Jesus was arrested? (See Luke 22:49-51 for the rest of the story.)
4. What was the “cup” that God had given Jesus to drink? (See 2 Corinthians 5:21 and 3 Nephi 5:12)

Jesus Taken to Annas (12 – 14)

5. Who was Annas? Who was Caiaphas?

Peter’s First Denial (15 – 18)

6. Who was it that asked Peter if he was one of Jesus’ disciples? What did he do?

The High Priest Questions Jesus (19 – 24)

7. What had Caiaphas, the High Priest, unknowingly prophesied about Jesus earlier? (See John 11:50, 51)

Peter’s Second and Third Denials (25 – 27)

8. Peter denied Jesus the night of His arrest. It is probable that the questions to him may have been sincere inquiries, in that the people want to know more about Jesus! Are we any different than Peter? We may answer yes when people ask us are we Christians, but what are some ways that we deny Jesus even though we profess to be His disciples?

Jesus Before Pilate (28 – 40)

9. Who was Pilate? Who's authority did he represent?
10. Pilate asked Jesus, "What is truth?" What is truth? (See Section 90:4 – 5a) Who is truth? (See also Genesis 9:22)
11. When Pilate offered to release a prisoner for the Passover feast, whom did the Jews choose? Who was he?
